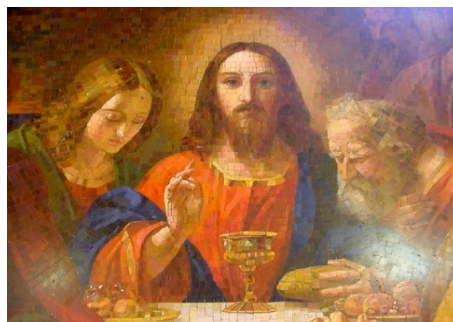


Eucharistic Ministers at Mass & to the Homebound and Nursing Homes

As a Eucharistic Minister, you assist the priest in distributing the Body and Blood of Christ at Mass. This ministry brings great joy and blessings not only to those who are served but to those who serve.

If you think you would be interested in the ministry, contact our pastor, or when he asks those who are interested to apply, please do so.

There are some requirements that will need to be investigated. An Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist at St. John Neumann Parish is to be a Catholic in good standing, a faithful communicant, and a member of our parish with a desire to serve God. To the Homebound & Nursing Homes

Above and beyond the confines of our church, Eucharistic Ministers are called to make Our Lord present to our homebound, disabled, and those residing temporarily or permanently in one of three nursing homes relying on St. John Neumann’s chaplaincy. You must already be Eucharistic Minister in our Diocese & meet the same requirements as our Eucharistic Ministers to apply.

If you had retired from being a Eucharistic Minister at Mass because of age or disability, yet are still able to drive and get around, you may still be able to serve in the ministry to which you had been called: nursing homes are accessible! This ministry unites our Lord to the faithful wherever they may be, and to extend your availability based on ability is Charity.
