We provide lay support to St. John Neumann Parish by serving as ushers, lectors, altar servers, and Eucharistic Ministers both at Mass and to the homebound.

We have established the Tom Wallace Scholarship Program that grants merit scholarships to high school students from our parish who are practicing Catholics and are going to Catholic High Schools.

Our Council sponsors The Parish of St. John Neumann pancake breakfast held on the second Sunday of every month in the St. Raymond Parish Hall. We also sponsor the Parish spaghetti dinner held on the fourth Sunday of the month throughout the year in the St. Raymond Parish Hall.

Our Council 3546 runs the kitchen at the Parish Christmas Bazaar held in early November each year in the St. John of God Parish Hall.

We have a flag distribution program at all the Masses at both campuses on the weekend before Veterans Day each year.

For our youth we lend financial support to the Christ Child Society to purchase winter jackets for those children who need them. We sponsor a seminarian letter writing program in which our CCD students compose and send letters of encouragement to the young men studying to be priests. Our Council hosts a basketball free throw shooting contest in January, a spelling bee in February, and a "Keep Christ in Christmas" poster contest during the Christmas Season.

Additionally we lend support to New Jersey Right to Life when called upon by NJRTL organization.

Council 3546 meets on the first Thursday of each month at 7:00 at St. Raymond Parish Hall. Rosary is said at 6:40 prior to the business meeting.
