- 4/23/2009 Rev. Ernest R. Soprano, K.H.S. resigned as Pastor of St. Francis, Vineland, NJ.
- 5/15/2009 Rev. Ernest R. Soprano, K.H.S. appointed Parochial Vicar for the pending merger of St. Raymond Church and St. John of God Church.

- 6/23/2010 Official first Day as the Parish of St. John Neumann.
- 6/25/2010 First Marriage as St. John Neumann Parish – Michael Gurdineer and Allison A. Richards by Rev. Christopher Bakey.
- 6/28/2010 Msgr. Timothy Ryan joins St. John Neumann Parish as retired priest in residence.

- May 2016 Corporal Work: Visit the Imprisoned - Stamped envelopes, writing materials were collected and donated to prisoners in South Jersey from our parish.
- June 2016 Corporal Work: Clothe the Naked – diapers, wipes, onesies collected for newborns.
- 9/1/2016 We welcome our new Welcome Ministry who has begun welcoming our new parishioners!
- 1/31/2017 Msgr. Timothy Ryan retires to St. Mary’s in Cherry Hill and Rev. Sigfrido Troche, M.SS.CC parts from our parish – both with our thanks, our prayers, and our warm wishes!
- 2/25/2017 Father Cesar A. Rebolledo Ramirez in residence at Notre Dame de la Mer will be offering Mass at 5pm on Sundays and administering Sacraments for our Spanish speaking parishioners.
- 3/26/2017 Our Knights of Columbus host their 1<sup>st</sup> Spaghetti Dinner to benefit our parish in our hall on Town Bank Road. A Grand Success!
- 4/1/2017 Rev. Robert J. Fritz returns in residence in our parish (for a repeat performance)!
- 6/11/2017 Our Knights Of Columbus, Stella Maris Council 3546, held their “Rock for Kids Music Festival” on the grounds of St. John of God Campus for the first time. This was their 5<sup>th</sup> annual event.
- 6/14/2017 Father Soprano celebrated our 1<sup>st</sup> Blue Mass at St. John of God Church on Flag Day.
- June 2017 The stained glass windows from behind the Altar at St. John of God were repurposed in our Arctic Entrance. They are both decorative and filter the light coming in!

- 11/4/2017 Our Military Outreach debuts our line of Military Teddy Bears, “Go Bags” for those promoting the sales of our rosaries, and “Cammo” Brochure & Rosary holders for businesses and organizations wishing to promote our cause at our annual Christmas Bazaar
- 12/10/2017 Our Legion of Mary begins leading and hosting their Praesidium’s Curia Meetings.

- 2/14/2018 Our new Crucifix was viewed publicly for the first time at our Ash Wednesday Mass at St. John of God church. This Crucifix will be Blessed by Bishop Sullivan at noon on May 17th.
- January 2018 *Going Green!* ~ New Energy Efficient Air Conditioning replaces unrepairable unit at St. John of God Hall.
- Spring 2018 Blessing Bags were introduced by our Parish Council to aid individuals in need with personal care necessities. Assembled by our CCD students, they are carried by parishioners to hand out to those in need as they are encountered.
- Spring 2018 *Going Green!* ~ Finalized Solar Projects at *both* St. Raymond and St. John of God campuses
- June 2018 Catholic Strong Capital Campaign presented to parish population in-pew.
- July 2018 *Catholic Strong Initiative* ~ Resurfacing of Church parking lot at St. Raymond completed.
- Oct./Nov. 2018 *Catholic Strong Initiative* ~ Paving completed around St. John of God Church for Handicapped Access to all entrances.

- 7/15/2019 Our Diocese’s “Vitality” Healthcare Ministry met with four of our ministries to the homebound to provide viable information and contacts we can use to aid those to whom we minister.
- August 2019 Our Retail Shoppe reorganized our space and created new advertisements, business cards, and posters to include not only items for sale but our Living Library & Pray it Forward aspects; one can take & pass on books, rosaries & medal, or religious gifts from our “gently used” and donated items (no donation required). This allows those of any means to minister and evangelize by circulating these items ~ expanding on Father Soprano’s “Living Library concept” that these items be used and make a difference in one’s faith and not remain on one of our shelves gathering dust. - 9/21/2019 Our Parish Pro-Life Ministry kicks off its 1<sup>st</sup> parish wide Spiritual adoption. Prayers will be offered for them daily for the next 9 months.
- 10/5/2019 Our Pro-life Ministry conducted their first Pro-Life post card drive addressed to our local government representatives. They were hand delivered by Father Soprano and Mike Beck.
- 2/22/2020 Msgr. Timothy Ryan passed away. His Funeral Mass was celebrated at St. John of God Church by Bishop Dennis Sullivan and Father Soprano, who offered the Homily for his friend. May He Rest In God’s Peace!
- March 2020 Windows were replaced at our Convent & School. This will improve energy efficiency, and also achieved one of our Catholic Strong Goals.
- 3/20/2020 Mass, Events, Office & Building closed due to the COVID 19 pandemic.
- 4/21/2020 Fr. Gerald M. Dolan, who had assisted our parish for several summers passed away. May He Rest In God’s Peace!
- 6/23/2020 St. John Neumann Parish marked our 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary as a merged entity amidst COVID quarantine. St Raymond Church and St. John of God Church united on 6/23/2010.
