Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

Before confession and, hopefully, everyday, we ought to examine our conscience. “Where was God at work today?” “What gifts/ blessings did He bestow on me?” “What is God asking of me?” “When did I act against God’s will?” These questions should help us to know God better and see how he is present in our lives.

This week there was a verse from the responsorial psalm that stood out “Cleanse me from my unknown faults!” (Ps19:12). Dr. Peter Kreeft in *Food for the Soul* (Word on Fire: 2023) also reflected on this verse. He reminded his readers that there are many of our failings and even vices of which we are unaware.

“For instance, the Pharisees were serious sinners, proud and arrogant and self-righteous, but they did not know that; in fact, they thought they were saints! Great sinners often think they are saints, while saints always know they are sinners. ... Many proud people think they are humble, and they are proud of their humility; but all who are humble know they are guilty of pride.” (p. 699). Imagine if celebrities, politicians, and our neighbors took this to heart!!

I recommend that when we examine our conscience we include asking forgiveness for our failure to love God as we ought and for any other faults or failings of which we may not be aware. This, along with diligence in our spiritual and charitable lives, will help us to grow in virtue and become closer to God.

Dehumanization and the Unborn Child

Catholic Catechism (2270) “Human Life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception.”

The entire issue of abortion revolves around whether one believes life begins at conception. If you believe that the life within the mother is simply a “clump of cells” then abortion can now become guilt free. It has become the goal of the abortion movement to diminish the status of the fetus from human life to that of a group of cells on a petri dish.

History has given us a number of examples of dehumanization, some from the not so distant past such as slavery here in America and in many parts of the world. And also in the Nazi controlled extermination camps of Europe where Jews, gypsies, and others were depicted as less than human and therefore subject to elimination on a massive scale. *The idea is that dehumanization permits violence by removing moral inhibitions against harming other people.* We are watching that process before our eyes in America as our society and our language has reclassified the living fetus (baby) as simply a “clump of cells” worthy of rejection. It is a simple strategy: no life equals no guilt. The pro abortion people have particularly targeted the young folk of this nation with their false propaganda. And for a generation that wants their pleasure without the consequences of an unwanted baby, this is just the argument they were looking for.



Many of us came from large families back in the 50's and 60's, and I can remember being with Mom who was pregnant and at the store when a neighbor would ask, “how's the baby doing?” And yet never once did I hear someone ask, “how's that clump of cells coming along?”

We were much smarter then.

Pray every day the Bishop Sheen prayer to end abortion: “Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion.”

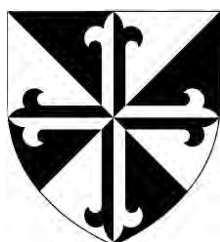
