Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

On the evening of Halloween, October 31st, we will have the 5pm Vigil Mass in English at Saint Raymond's for the feast day. Following that Mass, there will be Exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament in reparation for abuses to the Eucharist. A Mass of Reparation will be celebrated at midnight at Saint Raymond's.

On All Saints Day, November 1st, there will be 9am Mass in English at St. John of God and 7pm Mass at Saint Raymond in Spanish.

On Saturday, November 2nd, the Church celebrates the commemoration of all the faithful departed, known also as All Souls Day.

The 9am Mass at Saint Raymond's for First Saturday will be offered in English for all the faithful departed. There will be a 7pm Mass celebrated at Saint Raymond's in Spanish for all the faithful departed. The normal 4 o'clock Mass at St. John of God will be celebrated as the Vigil of the 30th Sunday in ordinary time.

There is a custom of the Church that priests may celebrate three Masses on All Souls Day. Father King will celebrate a private Mass at St. John of God in the chapel at 7:30am. Father Cesar will celebrate a private Mass at noon in Spanish at Saint Raymond. People are welcome to attend these as the churches will be open.

Let us all remember our departed loved ones and all the faithful departed during this month of November.

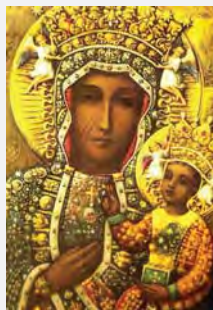

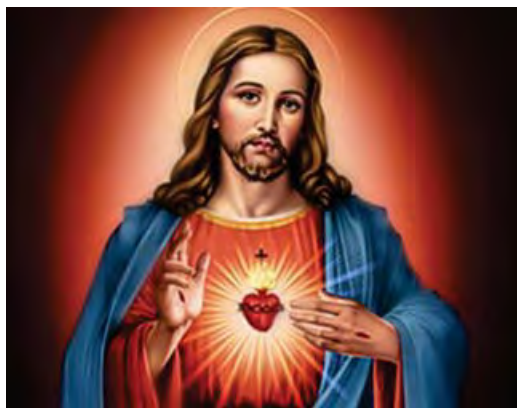

El Sacramento de la Reconciliación

El Sacramento de la Reconciliación tiene varios nombres, como por ejemplo la Confesión o la penitencia. Los nombres tienen el mismo propósito, **recibir el perdón de Dios** a través del Sacerdote. Podrías preguntar, ¿Cuándo fue instituido y por quién? Todos los Sacramentos fueron instituidos por Jesucristo. El cuando es importante. Te acuerdas el viernes santo todos los apóstoles de Jesús lo dejaron abandonado, Pedro negándole tres veces. Entonces, la noche de la Resurrección Jesús mandó a María Magdalena a decirles a los apóstoles que El vendría muy pronto a reunirse con ellos. ¡Que susto! ¿Qué le va a decir, nos va a retar? A los apóstoles les dio vergüenza, miedo y se sintieron apenados por haber dejado a Jesús en la cruz sólo.

Se dirían unos a otros ¿que nos dirá? ¿Pero adivinen lo que les dijo? **PAZ** a ustedes y tuvo que decirle otra vez **PAZ**. Al pesar de negar a Jesús, El les perdonó a sus apóstoles como nos perdona a nosotros en el Sacramento de la Reconciliación con mucho cariño y amor.

No les retó no les castigó, les dijo; “como me envió mi Padre, así les envió yo. Reciban el Espíritu Santo, a quien les perdonen los pecados, les serán perdonados; y a los que no se los perdonen, no les serán perdonados. **(Juan 20:19-23)**

Como ves, Jesús mismo dio a los sacerdotes el **Poder** para perdonar los pecados. Algunas personas de sectas dicen que no se necesita confesarse con el sacerdote, que solo hay que pedir perdón a Dios directamente. **No te dejes confundir**, esto **NO** es cierto. En el Evangelio citado arriba vemos muy claro que Cristo da a sus apóstoles (los primeros Sacerdotes) el poder de perdonar los pecados.

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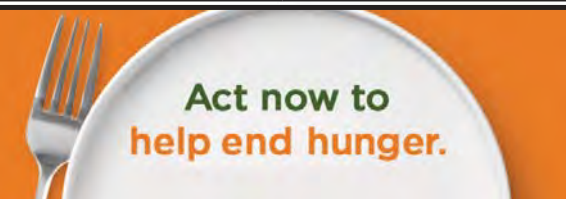
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
