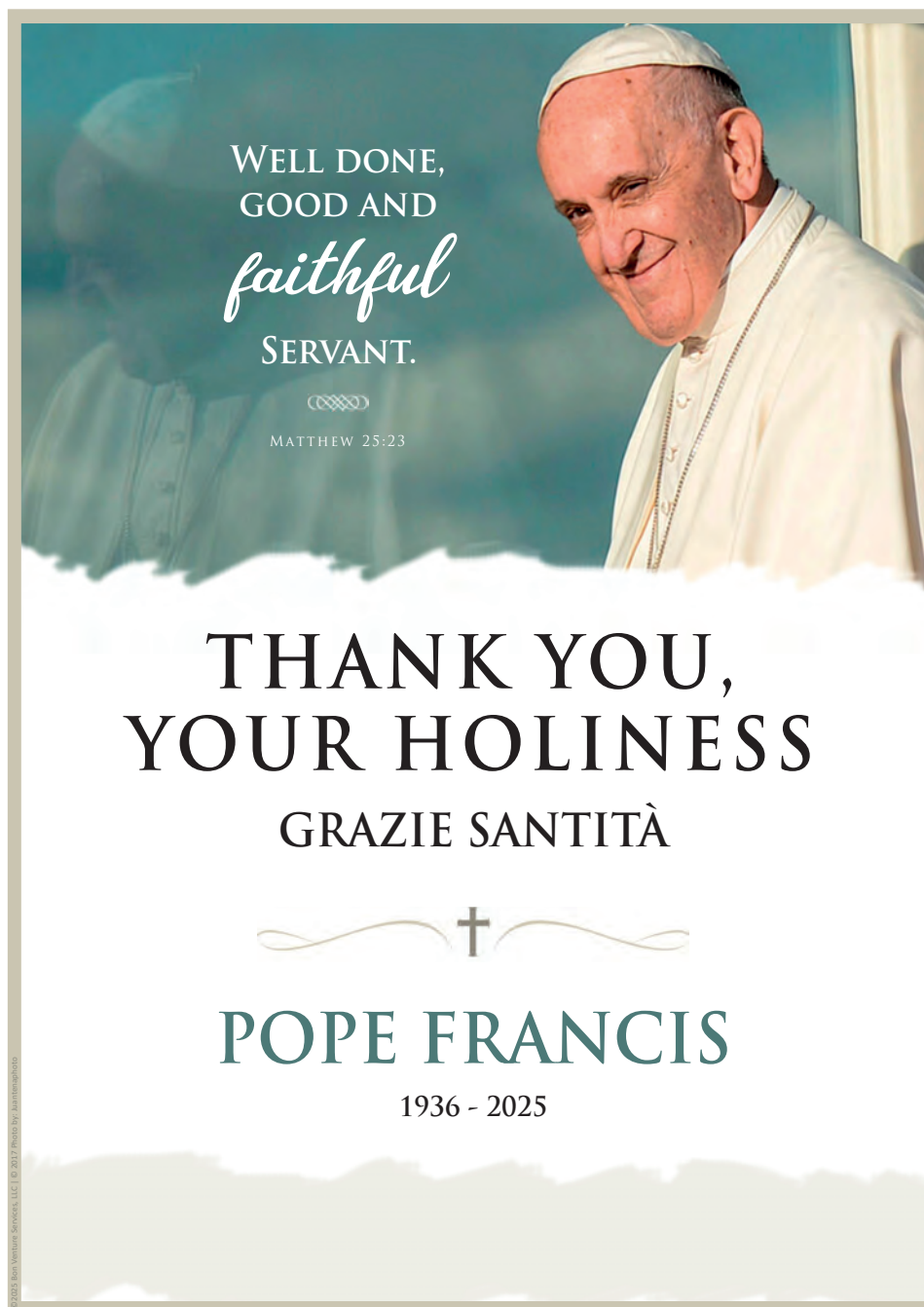

## Sacraments

**RECONCILIATION** - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

**BAPTISM** - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK** - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

## PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION

- Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY** - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

**SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS** If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Sunday. Based on private revelation to Sr. Maria Faustina Kowalska, the Feast of the Divine Mercy helps us to understand Christ Jesus’ overwhelming love for each of us. St. Faustina had visions of Christ over several years in which He asked the nun to make known His great desire to shower us with mercy. He asked her to paint an image of Him as He appeared to her, with two rays coming forth from His heart denoting Blood and Water, the mercy which flowed for all after His



heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. He asked her to put the words, “Jesus, I trust in You” as a signature. The image is in the front of St. John of God Church and in the back of St. Raymond Church.

## **Sorrow and Regret**

Numbers suggest that Catholic women are just as likely to have an abortion as any other group in our country. According to the Guttmacher Institute, 24% of women having abortions identified as Catholic, which closely mimics the 22% of women who overall identify as Catholic. Many of us come from a generation when abortion would have been unthinkable; but our children and grandchildren do not, and so many of our families are left with the scar that the loss of a child due to abortion brings. Make no mistake about abortion: “since the first century the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion.” (CCC 2271) And that evil extends to anyone who assists in an abortion: “Formal cooperation in an abortion constitutes a grave offense.” (2272) But the awesome truth about our Faith is that there is always hope, always a way back to God. The confessional is always the first stop on our return to God.

“Come now, and let us set things right says the LORD, “Though your sins are as scarlet, They will be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They will be like wool.” (Is. 1:18)

But how many regret their participation in the abortion? Studies are inconsistent on this but according to LifeNews, “grief is much more common, and more intensely felt, than relief.” According to their findings, relief was prominent only among the 30% of women who described their abortions as “wanted and consistent with my values and preferences.” The study showed that 70% reported feeling pressured to abort by other



people or circumstances.

Sometimes, however, besides the confessional, we feel the need to talk to

someone who has “been there”. This works for such groups as veterans, victims of crime, survivors of illnesses, and the list goes on. It just helps to talk with someone with a shared experience.

Weekend retreats offer you a supportive, confidential and nonjudgmental environment where women and men can express, release and reconcile painful post-abortive emotions to begin the process of restoration, renewal and healing. As Catholics we begin with prayer for those who suffer from the effects of participation in an abortion. And while doing so, we are always mindful to support, not judge. For as Jesus said to his disciples:

“Be **merciful**, just as your Father is **merciful**.” (Luke 6:36)

## ¿Cuál es el significado del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia?



En las revelaciones sobre la Divina Misericordia que hizo a Santa Faustina, Jesús le pidió en varias ocasiones que se dedicara una fiesta a la Divina Misericordia, y que fuera el domingo siguiente a Pascua. Los textos litúrgicos de ese

día, el segundo domingo de Pascua, tratan sobre la institución del Sacramento de la Penitencia, el Tribunal de la Divina Misericordia, por lo que ya están en consonancia con el pedido de Nuestro Señor. Esta Fiesta, que ya se había concedido a Polonia y se había celebrado en la Ciudad del Vaticano, fue otorgada a la Iglesia Universal por el Papa Juan Pablo II en ocasión de la canonización de Sor Faustina el 30 de abril de 2000. En un decreto con fecha 23 de mayo de 2000, la Congregación para el Culto Divino y la Disciplina de los Sacramentos declaró que “en todo el mundo, el Segundo Domingo de Pascua recibirá el nombre de Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, una invitación perenne para el mundo cristiano a afrontar, con confianza en la benevolencia divina, las dificultades y las pruebas que esperan al género humano en los años venideros”.

Respecto a la Fiesta de la Misericordia, Jesús dijo:

Quien se acerque ese día a la Fuente de Vida recibirá el perdón total de las culpas y de las penas. (Diario, 300)

Quiero que la imagen sea bendecida solemnemente el primer domingo después de Pascua y que se la venere públicamente para que cada alma pueda saber de ella. (Diario, 341)

Esta Fiesta ha salido de las entrañas de Mi misericordia y está confirmada en el abismo de Mis gracias. (Diario, 420)

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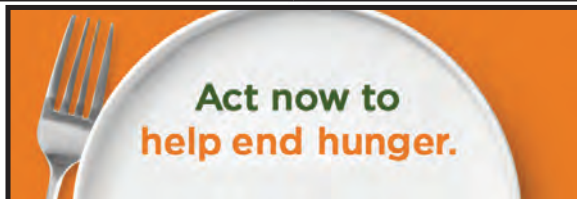
