

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST

AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

Today we celebrate three important things:

- 1. The Ascension of Our Lord into Heaven
- 2. The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus
- 3. The beginning of FORMED for our parish

Our Lord's Ascension ended His "earthly" ministry as He returned to the Father. In Matthew's Gospel He said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." He calls us to "teach" as we follow His commandments. In order to "teach" (share our faith) we must know and be formed in our faith first.

FORMED from the Augustine Institute is like Netflix for understanding the Catholic Faith. I ask each of our parishioners to please access FORMED on their computer, smartphone, or smart TV. Create a new account. Just enter your email address and the parish Zip Code (08204), click "Parish of St. John Neumann" and you're in!

I invite everyone to explore the content. I suggest starting with "The Search" program. This series is comprised of seven episodes, each about 25 minutes long. They are well done and provide a great foundation for learning more about our faith.

Each week we will make suggestions for different programs to watch or listen to.





The State of Our State



The New Jersey Assembly is at it again. Just when you thought the fight to save the lives of unborn children had become easier with the Dobbs Supreme Court

decision and the election of a pro-life friendly President Trump, the NJ Assembly had to go and ruin our party by fostering three bills recently to help in what they sadly call "women's reproductive rights." We, as Catholics, call it the taking of a human life.

A 861: Provides certain deceptive practices in advertising of pregnancy-related services violate the consumer fraud act. (This act would target crisis pregnancy centers, such as the one we support, the Jersey Shore Women's Center in Galloway Township.)

A 4915: **Establishes reproductive health travel advisory.** (The travel advisory shall inform New Jersey residents of the extent to which states within the United States restrict access to "reproductive healthcare services.")

A 3418: Enters New Jersey in Women's Reproductive Health Care Compact. (Under that compact, member states would block the extradition or investigation of people who get or provide abortions by states that restrict the procedure, among other things.)

And unbelievably, *released on Mother's Day*, Planned Parenthood's 2023-2024 annual report, titled "A Force for Hope," revealed that the organization provided 402,230 abortions over the year, an increase of nearly 10,000 abortions from the previous year's report and a record high in the abortion giant's history.

As abortions increased, taxpayer funding increased as well. Public funding for Planned Parenthood was up by about \$100 million from the previous year's report. At \$792.2 million, taxpayer dollars made up nearly 40% of Planned Parenthood's revenue. (Catholic News Agency)

"If the tax money doesn't upset you, then the \$1,286,000,000 spent on so-called 'medical services' might. The American people funded nearly half of all of Planned Parenthood's evil deeds. This included 402,230 abortions, sex education for young children, cross sex hormone distribution and, of course, the distribution of the deadly abortion pill," remarked American Life League Director Katie Brown Xavios. (LifeSite)

So no, we cannot relax. We need your prayers for those unborn children sentenced to the abortion mills as well as prayers for the hope that their mothers will realize that life exists within them. It is not simply tissue, it is a baby.

And please, continue to say our Bishop Sheen prayer for all the unborn children.
