

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST

AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.



Glory to Jesus Christ!

In just a few weeks we will be celebrating the anniversary of the Latino Ministry returning to our parish. As

you may remember, there had been some Spanish language ministry at our parish on and off over the past 20 years. Much of it has been centered at St. Raymond Church.

Two years ago, Bishop Sullivan assigned Fr. Cesar to be with us here and to move the Latino Community to our parish. Then in July of 2024, Bishop Sullivan designated St. Raymond Church as the home of the Regional Hispanic Ministry for Cape May County.

Saint Raymond Regional Hispanic Ministry is not "just another" ministry in our parish like our wonderful Holy Name Society or St. Vincent de Paul. It is an initiative of the diocese to serve all Hispanic Catholics who live south of Ocean City. The Regional Hispanic Ministry is supported by 7 parishes in our region. The number of Latinos in our area continues to grow. Many are attracted here by so many work opportunities, especially in the summer months. Well over two thirds of the children in our religious education program come from Latino families. And, as you can see, the community supports many activities and programs to attract and evangelize beyond our parish borders.

As pastor, I believe that our parish is the better for working with the Saint Raymond Regional Hispanic Ministry. We continue to work together to build up the Kingdom of God here in Cape May County.

Several years ago, the Parish of St. John Neumann began a Community Emergency Disaster Relief Fund. To that end all monies collected at 5th Friday Bingo would go to support any family, regardless of church affiliation, who had a house fire, flood, etc.

Thanks to your generosity we have helped about half a dozen families at times of great crisis. In addition, we have been able to put away over \$15,000 in reserve to help any other families in need.


We have decided that, instead of just keeping any future money set aside that we will give all money collected on 5th Friday to our parish's St. Vincent de Paul Society to be used now for families in need. The St. Vincent de Paul Society (SVdP) provides immediate assistance to families or individuals who need a place to stay, need food or utility assistance, or other short-term help.

If there is a community disaster and we dip below the prudent reserve of \$15,000, then 5th Friday Bingo proceeds will go back into the Community Emergency Disaster Relief Fund until it once again reaches to reserve.

Pro Life Ministry Abortion in America

Abortion Centers Closed in Iowa and Minnesota

The loss of \$2.8 million in federal Title X funds, frozen by the Trump administration in April, along with Iowa's protective six-week abortion ban has resulted in the closure of a total of eight Planned Parenthood abortion centers, four in each state. There will still be 15 other centers remaining open, but the pendulum definitely is shifting towards the prolife movement. Iowa's new abortion law has reduced abortions by 60% in the first six months. (LifeNews.com)

Covid Shots and Miscarriages

Dr. James Thorp, a board-certified OB-GYN and maternal fetal medicine specialist with over 44 years of clinical experience, testified on May 21st before a Senate hearing on adverse events of Covid-19 shots that "the raw data revealed an 82% miscarriage rate in women vaccinated during the first trimester." (LifeSite)

He further testified "this figure mirrors the effects of chemical abortion drugs such as RU486." He went on to criticize a New England Journal of Medicine study as misleading which showed a much lower rate and stated that medical "publications were riddled with conflicts of interest and deliberate misrepresentations intended to coerce pregnant women into taking vaccines." Between 2020 and 2022, pharmaceutical companies paid \$1.06 billion to reviewers at leading medical journals. Dr. Thorp explained that the promotion of COVID-19 vaccines to pregnant women was done in order to influence the American

public's perception of the COVID-19 shot as safe, because if pregnant women "could be convinced that the vaccine was safe and effective, it would imply that it was safe and effective for everyone."

Review of the Abortion Pill

U.S. Secretary of Health and Human Services Robert F. Kennedy Jr announced a review of the regulation and labeling of the abortion pill mifepristone following new evidence of safety concerns regarding its current use. A study by the Ethics and Public Policy Center found that a serious health concern will occur within 45 days for 1 in 10 women who take the abortion pill mifepristone. The rate of serious side effects is 22 times higher than the FDA approved label would indicate.

¿Qué significa las 40 horas en la Iglesia?



La adoración de las 40 horas, o Devoción de las 40 Horas, es una práctica religiosa católica que consiste en la exposición del Santísimo Sacramento para

adoración continua durante 40 horas. Esta devoción tiene raíces en la tradición de la Iglesia que celebra la resurrección de Cristo después de 40 horas en el sepulcro.

La práctica surgió en Milán alrededor de 1530. Desde allí, se extendió por Italia, Europa y finalmente a América. 


