

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST

AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

I am grateful to be pastor of such a giving and supportive parish. I know that many parishes in our diocese

struggle to make ends meet. Sometimes they need to delay needed repairs in order to pay salaries and bills. When I arrived here, there was over \$20k in the "Emergency Repair Fund" to help offset some of our repairs. Since then, we have had an annual second collection to keep this fund supplied.

Last year, due to your generosity, we collected ~\$17,000 for the "Emergency Repair Fund." THANK YOU! However, since then, we have spent ~\$25,000 on repairs! These have included:

- Air Conditioning at St. John of God Church
- Air Conditioning at St. Raymond Church (before it went down for good and had to be replaced)
- Lawn mower (St. John of God)
- Toilet repair (at St. John of God Church and Hall)
- Valve Replacement (St. Raymond School building)
- Irrigation pipe repair (St. Raymond Campus)
- Kitchen plumbing repair (Convent)
- Replace breakers (School/Convent)
- Repair gutter/downspout/roof (St. Raymond Hall)
- Organ repair (St. Raymond Church)
- Parking Lot light repair (St. John of God)
- Emergency Exit sign repair (St. John of God Church)
- Bathroom repair (School)
- Alarm repair (St. Raymond Hall)
- Heater repair (St. John of God Hall/Offices)
- Refrigerator repair (St. John of God Rectory)
- And MORE!

Like your homes, our buildings need constant up-keep. I thank you for all you have contributed and I ask you to consider donating to the "Emergency Repair Fund" – the second collection on July 5th-6th.
