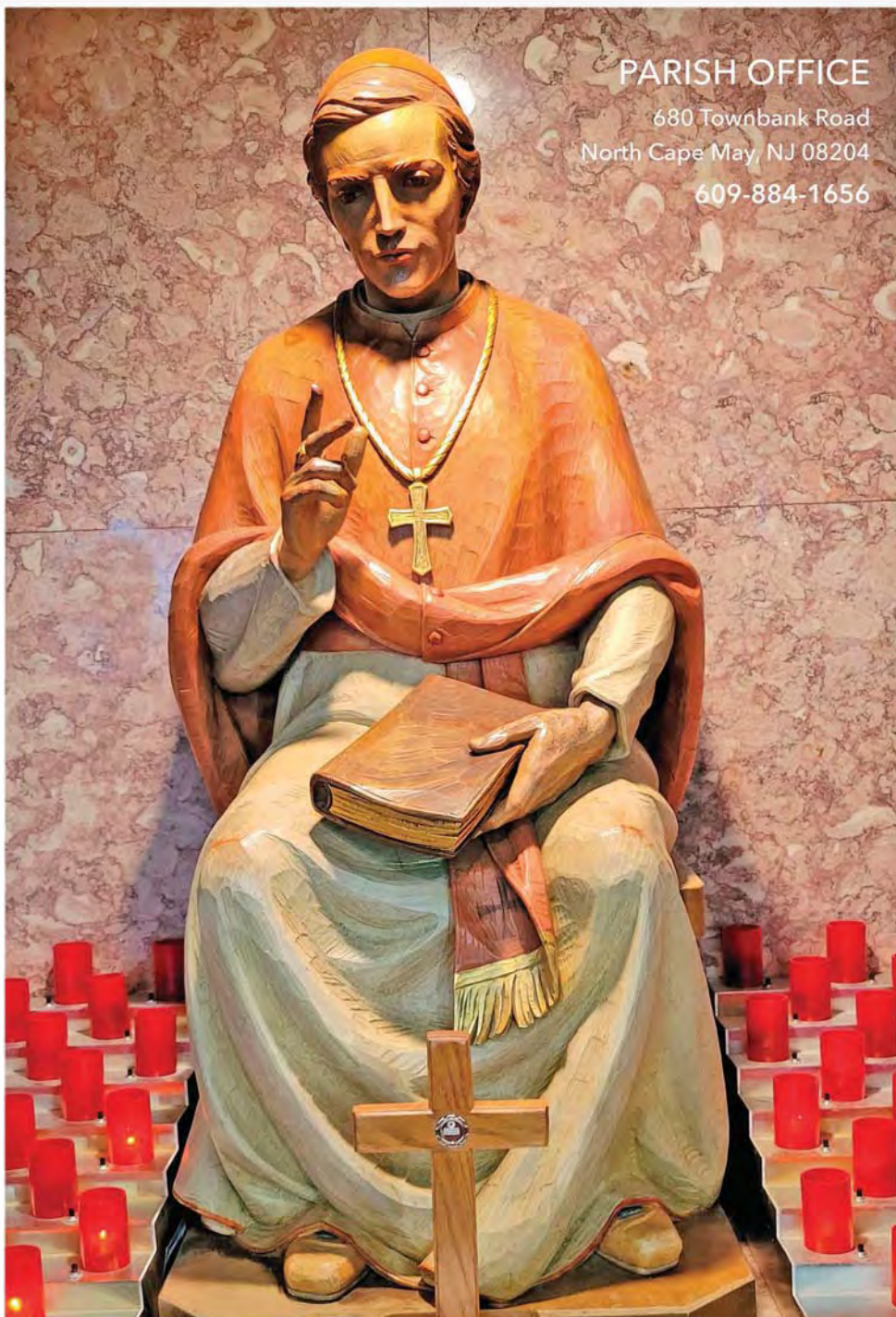

Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION

- Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

Happy Independence Day!

When I was in the seminary,
when it would get to be close

to summertime we would hear the same expression: "Don't take a vacation from your vocation!" Meaning, "You're still a seminarian even on summer break!" I know that if you are reading this you are already attending Mass or supporting our parish in some way. However, a challenge: "Vacation" comes from the Latin word "vacare" meaning to be empty, free, or at leisure. But what is "leisure?"

Prof. Josef Pieper, the 20th century Catholic Philosopher, once wrote a magnificent book called *Leisure, the Basis of Culture*. It is worth reading. In it, Dr. Pieper argues that worship and prayer are meant to be at the center of our leisure and, by extension, the center of our culture. Sometimes we can get swept up either just resting so that we can work harder later on, or filling up our leisure time with so many "busy" activities. I invite you to take advantage of some of our parish offerings to fill your summertime with prayer and worship. We have daily Mass, daily rosary, Adoration, Secular Dominican prayer group/rosary. There is confession, summer Scripture Study, and lots of volunteer opportunities with the St. Vincent de Paul, Christ Child, and Holy Name Societies, as well as the Knights of Columbus. Not even to mention all that is going on in our Regional Hispanic Community. Please consider using some of your leisure to grow closer to God through Worship, Prayer, and Service!

CANONICAL CORONATION



To commemorate the 150th Anniversary, a Canonical Coronation has been granted by Papal decree, a rare and profound honor bestowed by the authority of Pope Francis. He has recognized the longstanding tradition of the **Mt. Carmel Procession of the Mount Carmel**

Society! The coronation will be celebrated by Bishop Joseph A. Williams during the 2:00 PM Our Lady of Mount Carmel Society Mass on the Feast Day, July 16th, as he crowns the Baby Jesus in honor of Our Lady.

A canonical coronation is a formal act by the Pope, expressed through a papal bull, to crown a venerated image of Christ, the Blessed Virgin Mary, or St. Joseph. This act acknowledges the image's local and universal significance within the Catholic Church. This is a rare honor for the church and our diocese. In the United States, only four Marian images have received this honor:

1. Our Lady of Prompt Succor: Crowned on November 10, 1895, in New Orleans, Louisiana.
2. Our Lady of Mount Carmel: Crowned on July 10, 1904, in New York City, New York.
3. Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception: Crowned on August 22, 2013, in Lake Charles, Louisiana.
4. Our Lady of La Leche: Crowned on October 10, 2021, at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine in Florida.

And the Our Lady of Mount Carmel Statue in Hammonton will be the fifth in the whole country!
