Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION

- Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

Today we hear the famous parable of “the Good Samaritan.” In this story a foreigner, a person who would

not associate with a devout Jewish person (and vice versa), cares for a Jewish man who has been beaten and robbed. He does not simply take him to a hospital, but cares for him himself and then provides for his continued recovery.

Many years ago when I was stationed at a parish in Camden, I was introduced to a term: NIMBY or NIMBYism. This is an acronym for “Not In My Back Yard.” NIMBYism refers to a policy or concept that we might be in favor of but we don’t want to have close to use. A benign example would be a cell phone tower. We all want to have cell phone towers around but we don’t want one built where we can see it!

There is a more pressing aspect of NIMBYism in our community today: We like having an inexpensive labor force to provide service. So many of those who maintain our lawns, clean our homes, cook in our restaurants, build our houses, paint our homes, put on our roofs, are low-income people, often immigrants. But in the past few years there has been less and less affordable housing (renting or owning) in our area. Landlords would rather make many thousands of \$\$ through vacation rentals than less money through renting to workers or low income families. Many folks here on work visas (J-1) are slept 9+ to a room and need to go to food banks to feed themselves, all while working hard at various shops and restaurants. I have met several families (Fr. Cesar knows many more) who are looking for affordable housing because the landlords are selling in order to make more money.

We have a few options: Ignore the problem and hope it goes away. Pretend it is someone else’s problem. Do our homework. Stop patronizing any establishment that employs low-income workers - or we can become more aware and support those who are struggling in our community.

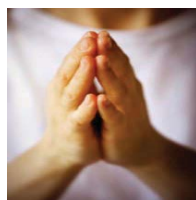

CANONICAL CORONATION



To commemorate the 150th Anniversary, a Canonical Coronation has been granted by Papal decree, a rare and profound honor bestowed by the authority of Pope Francis. He has recognized the longstanding tradition of the **Mt. Carmel Procession of the Mount Carmel**

Society! The coronation will be celebrated by Bishop Joseph A. Williams during the 2:00 PM Our Lady of Mount Carmel Society Mass on the Feast Day, July 16th, as he crowns the Baby Jesus in honor of Our Lady.

A canonical coronation is a formal act by the Pope, expressed through a papal bull, to crown a venerated image of Christ, the Blessed Virgin Mary, or St. Joseph. This act acknowledges the image's local and universal significance within the Catholic Church. This is a rare honor for the church and our diocese. In the United States, only four Marian images have received this honor:

1. Our Lady of Prompt Succor: Crowned on November 10, 1895, in New Orleans, Louisiana.
2. Our Lady of Mount Carmel: Crowned on July 10, 1904, in New York City, New York.
3. Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception: Crowned on August 22, 2013, in Lake Charles, Louisiana.
4. Our Lady of La Leche: Crowned on October 10, 2021, at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Augustine in Florida.

And the Our Lady of Mount Carmel Statue in Hammonton will be the fifth in the whole country!
