Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION

- Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

Sunday, August 31 is the Feast
of St. Raymond Nonnatus, pa-
tron of St. Raymond Church

and a co-patron of our parish. St. Raymond
was a 12th-13th Mercedarian friar, priest,
and cardinal. His mother died shortly before
he was born, he had to be quickly delivered
by cesarean section after her death. Thus, he
received the name non-natus or “not born” in
Latin. Because of this and his great devotion
to the Blessed Mother, he is invoked as a pa-
tron of expectant mothers, childbirth, and
difficult pregnancies.

This year as his feast falls on Sunday, we
will not be having a special Mass in his hon-
or. Rather, the night before, we will have a
prayer service where we will have a special
blessing of candles and water for protection
against evil and divine favor for pregnancy
and childbirth. Please bring your own can-
dles and bottles though we will have some
available. Afterwards we will go over to St.
Raymond Hall for an ice cream party in his
honor!

I hope to see you there, Saturday, August
30th, 7pm at St. Raymond Church and Hall.

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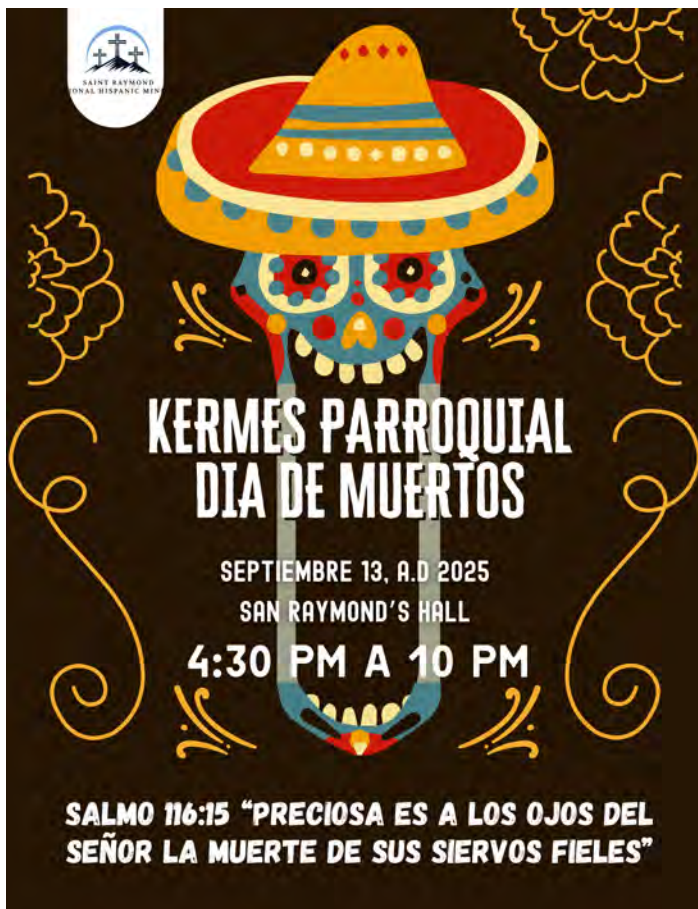
