Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION

- Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Some updates: In the past
months we have new concrete
work around St. Raymond

campus: the parking lot and hall are now on
the same level to accommodate those with
walking difficulties. We have also redone the
entrance to the St. Raymond school building
to address the broken concrete. In the next
days we will be addressing some asphalt
needs to stop some water from pooling.

The air conditioning is a work in progress.
We have addressed one of the issues at St.
Raymond (bad electronics board) and are
working on the sensor in the Church. The
building was built in 1979 and does not have
a single window that can be opened! The
ventilation is terrible! It seems that the two
choices are either “stuffy” or “cold.” We
have had the HVAC company in again to
work on the sensors and thermostats. We re-
placed one condenser for the AC at St.
John’s Church and did a tune-up of the oth-
ers. Seems to be working well!

The new, high efficiency boiler has been in-
stalled at St. Raymond convent/school/
Hispanic Ministry Office. There are a few
more tweaks that it needs but, thanks to your
generosity and a grant program through the
State of NJ, we now have new, high efficien-
cy gas boilers in all 5 buildings!

With 40-60 year old buildings there is always
something to maintain. Thank you both for
your patience as well as your generosity in
all we do!

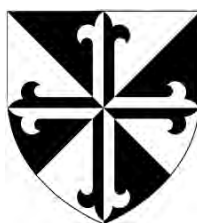

Knights of Columbus Council #3546 and the Jersey Shore Women's Center

There is a front line in the fight against abortion in our area, and it is located on Jimmie Leeds Road in Galloway Township. An abortion center here sits next door to the Jersey Shore Women's Center (JSWC) and it is there that the fight to save the lives of unborn children happens daily. We are a pro-life Faith, and this battle against the taking of unborn lives belongs to all of us. JSWC is open 6 days per week (59 hours) and, since 2021, has had over 5,600 client appointments. They have been so successful at the center that the abortion mill next door has reduced their hours from four full days per week to just two hours per week. JSWC's founder and president, Tricia Bradberry, was named 2024 Pro-Life Woman of the Year at the National Celebrate Life Conference, and Abby Johnson (*Unplanned*) sits on their Board. That's the good news, but the bad news is that Planned Parenthood recently opened a new facility down the street from Holy Spirit High School. The fight goes on.



The Knights of Columbus stand at the forefront of the pro-life movement. The Knights will always be there for mothers and their children, and they proclaim the dignity of all lives, born and unborn. And that is why on August 7th JSWC with checks totaling \$3000. Money was raised by the Knights through all the efforts you see in the Parish, such as the monthly breakfast, flower sales, the Comedy Night, and so on. Your money, channeled through activities by the Knights, goes to fight against abortion but also to support the mothers and their infants after birth. We cannot ask those without any support to walk this path alone; we must be there to support them and their children. And that takes money. So, while you attend our breakfasts, you not only get a fantastic meal but you help a mother make the decision to keep her baby safe from the abortion folks. Better yet, become a Knight and join us in our fight to preserve the lives of these unborn children. Change the future for a child, and for yourself.

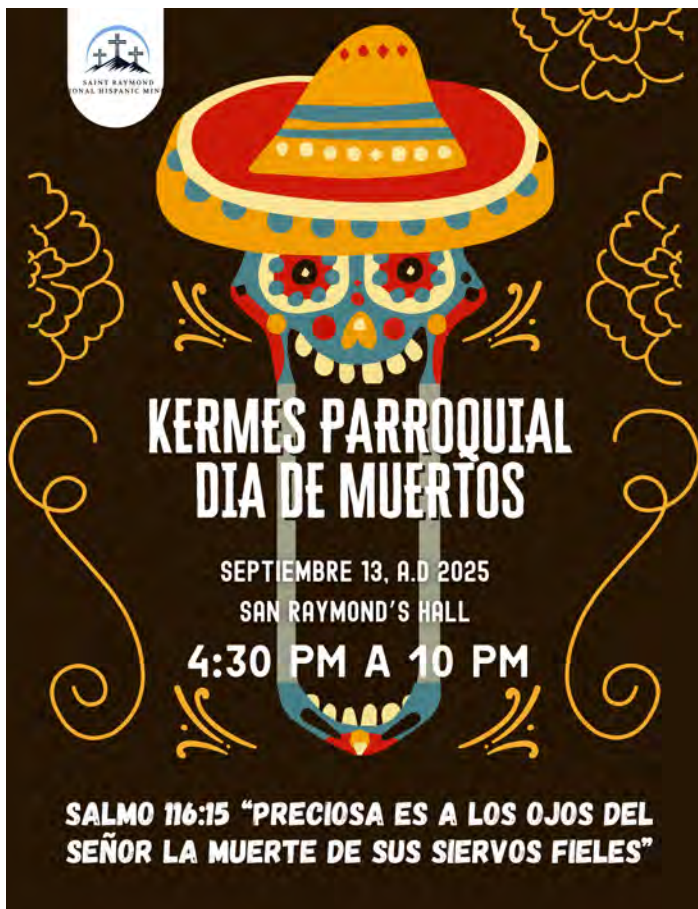
