

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST

AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

Int. of the Christ Child Society's Tribute and Memorial Honorees



From Father King

Glory to Jesus Christ! Last week we talked about two Saints who have nearly the same name. Our own patron, St. John Neumann,

and the British St. John Newman. Today we will talk a bit more about the Englishman.

St. John Henry Cardinal Newman was quite influential in Christian circles even while he was still an Anglican priest. He was involved in the Oxford Movement, which reintroduced many Catholic elements into the Church of England. After his conversion to Catholicism, Newman wrote a famous work *Apologia pro Vita Sua* (a Defense of My Life) in which he laid out the reasons for his conversion. His other two most influential works are *The Idea of a University* which he wrote around the time he was the founding rector of the Catholic University of Dublin, and *Essay on the Development of Christian*

Doctrine. His understanding of how Catholic Doctrine could grow since the Apostolic age is probably the greatest contribution to the history of the Church.

Cardinal Newman was beatified in 2010 by Pope Benedict XVI and canonized a saint in 2019 by Pope Francis. One of Pope Leo's first official acts as Pope has been to name him a Doctor of the Church. He has long been invoked as a patron of Catholic Education: Newman Centers and Societies at college campuses are named for him.

A final quote from St. John Newman: "To be deep in history is to cease to be a Protestant."

To conclude, there are two wonderful Catholic Saints with nearly the same name: St. Neumann is our patron; St. Newman is the newest Doctor of the Church. May both of them intercede for us!






