

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. 



La Muerte como Fin y Principio

Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica

II. MORIR EN CRISTO JESÚS

1005 Para resucitar con Cristo, es necesario morir con Cristo, es necesario "dejar este cuerpo para ir a morar cerca del Señor" (2 Co 5, 8). En esta "partida" (Flp 1, 23) que es la muerte, el alma se separa del cuerpo. Se reunirá con su cuerpo el día de la resurrección de los muertos.

La muerte

1006 "Frente a la muerte, el enigma de la condición humana alcanza su cumbre". En un sentido, la muerte corporal es natural, pero por la fe sabemos que realmente es "salario del pecado" (Rm 6, 23) Y para los que mueren en la gracia de Cristo, es una participación en la muerte del Señor para poder participar también en su Resurrección.

1007 La muerte es el final de la vida terrena. Nuestras vidas están medidas por el tiempo, en el curso del cual cambiamos, envejecemos y como en todos los seres vivos de la tierra, al final aparece la muerte como el desenlace normal de la vida. Este aspecto de la muerte da urgencia a nuestras vidas: el recuerdo de nuestra mortalidad sirve también para hacernos pensar que no contamos más que con un tiempo limitado para llevar a término nuestra vida:

Acuérdate de tu Creador en tus días mozos ..., mientras no vuelva el polvo a la tierra, a lo que era, y el espíritu vuelva a Dios que es quien lo dio» (Qo 12, 1. 7).
