

#### Sacraments

**RECONCILIATION** - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

**BAPTISM** - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

#### PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST

AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY** - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

**SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS** If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.





Father Cesar is offering a 12week Bible Study (in English) about the Blessed Mother which will examine her life, role, and significance in Christian doctrine, focusing on her





#### II. MORIR EN CRISTO JESÚS

1010 11). La novedad esencial de la muerte cristiana está ahí: por el Bautismo, el cristiano está ya sacramentalmente "muerto con Cristo", para vivir una vida nueva; y si morimos en la gracia de Cristo, la muerte física consuma este "morir con Cristo" y perfecciona así nuestra incorporación a Él en su acto redentor:

Para mi es mejor morir en ("eis") Cristo Jesús que reinar de un extremo a otro de la tierra. Lo busco a él, que ha resucitado por nosotros. Mi parto de aproxima... Dejadme recibir la luz pura; cuando yo llegue allí, seré un hombre.

1011 En la muerte, Dios llama al hombre hacia sí. Por eso, el cristiano puede experimentar hacia la muerte un deseo semejante al de San Pablo: "Deseo partir y estar con Cristo" (Flp 1, 23); y puede transformar su propia muerte en un acto de obediencia y de amor hacia el Padre, a ejemplo de Cristo:

Mi deseo terreno ha sido crucificado...; hay en mí un agua viva que murmura y que dice desde dentro de mí "ven al Padre".

Yo quiero ver a Dios y para verlo es necesario morir.

Yo no muero, entro en la vida.


