

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST

AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

A few weeks ago Pope Leo canonized two young people to be

saints: Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati. There has been a lot of talk on social media and elsewhere about St. Carlo Acutis since he is the first Millennial Saint to be canonized (he's actually younger than I am!). However, St. Pier Giorgio Frassati is also quite remarkable.

Born in Turin, Italy in 1901, he was a saint of his time. He was active in many social circles with an outstanding personality. He was a mountain climber, enjoyed the opera, the theater and museums. He had a deep spiritual life and spent much time in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. He attended Mass daily to receive Holy Communion.

But the most important aspect of his life was the service of the poor. It is said that the sick, those wounded in WWI, and the poor were his "masters." And what was the vehicle by which he served them? He was an active member of the local conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society! Though he couldn't always attend the meetings of the many Catholic prayer groups and organizations he belonged to, he always was active with SVdP. From the time he joined them at age 17 through his death at age 24, he lived his life as a Vincentian. Even beyond the normal work, he would give away all the money he had, even his own bus fare, when he would visit with the poor and suffering.

This weekend, as we celebrate St. Vincent de Paul (feast day September 27th), we look toward a remarkable Saint who pursued sanctity through the St. Vincent de Paul Society. St. Pier Giorgio Frassati, Pray for us!


RETREAT WITH FR. CESAR


Fr. Cesar will be offering a threeday retreat focusing on the Development of the Spiritual Life with teachings about St. Ignatius of


Padre Pio: Between Heaven and Earth



La Muerte como Fin y Principio

Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica

II. MORIR EN CRISTO JESÚS

1013 La muerte es el fin de la peregrinación terrena del hombre, del tiempo de gracia y de misericordia que Dios le ofrece para realizar su vida terrena según el designio divino y para decidir su último destino. Cuando ha tenido fin "el único curso de nuestra vida terrena", ya no volveremos a otras vidas terrenas. "Está establecido que los hombres mueran una sola vez" (Hb 9, 27). No hay "reencarnación" después de la muerte.

1014 La Iglesia nos anima a prepararnos para la hora de nuestra muerte ("De la muerte repentina e imprevista, líbranos Señor": antiguas Letanías de los santos), a pedir a la Madre de Dios que interceda por nosotros "en la hora de nuestra muerte:

Habrías de ordenarte en toda cosa como si luego hubieses de morir. Si tuvieses buena conciencia no temerías mucho la muerte. Mejor sería huir de los pecados que de la muerte. Si hoy no estás aparejado, ¿cómo lo estarás mañana?


