## Sacraments

**RECONCILIATION** - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

**BAPTISM** - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK** - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

## PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION

- Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY** - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

**SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS** If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

This month the Church in the United States celebrates "Pro-Life Month." We reflect on the dignity of human life from conception until natural death. In the Catholic Tradition, all human life is sacred because we are created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1). Therefore, to directly intend to take an innocent human life is always gravely evil. The late Cardinal Joseph Bernadin of Chicago, in 1984, came up with a concept called the "Seamless Garment" doctrine. In this teaching Cardinal Bernadin tried to emphasize the "consistent ethic of life" by likening it to Christ's seamless garment. It teaches that all the Church's teaching on life issues work together. We must reject any social policy or action that demeans the dignity and value of human life. According to the "Seamless Garment" doctrine, we must work against all affronts to human dignity. Cardinal Gerhard Müller, previous prefect of the Congregation of the Doctrine of the Faith, says that the "Seamless Garment" doctrine illustrates "how Catholic moral teaching is a consistent whole—uniting ethical, religious, and political threads in a unified moral vision.

We must be aware that sometimes people like to pick and choose which ethical, religious, and political issues are more or less valuable. We cannot separate. However, some evils are greater than others. Abortion and euthanasia always are the direct killing of an innocent human life. They are NEVER justified. Other issues, such as immigration, are more subtle. A government must strike a balance between working to preserve the dignity of immigrants while maintaining the right of the nation to secure its borders.

This month, as always, we stand up for what is right. We work to value the dignity of all life.

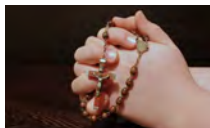

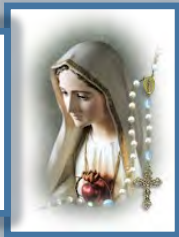

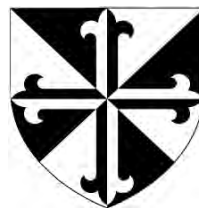

## John XXIII—The Pope of Peace

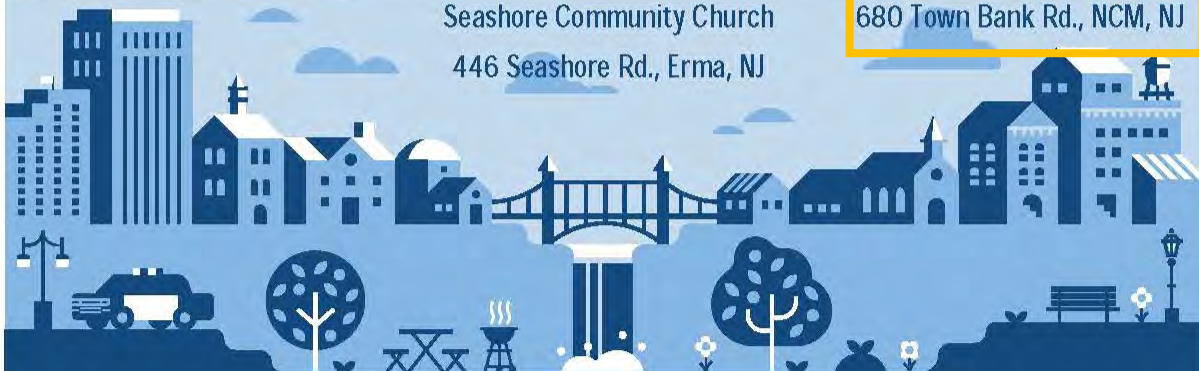

*Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica*

### II. MORIR EN CRISTO JESÚS. RESUMEN

**1015** “Caro salutis est cardo” (“La carne es soporte de la salvación”).

Creemos en Dios que es el creador de la carne; creemos en el Verbo hecho carne para rescatar la carne; creemos en la resurrección de la carne, perfección de la creación y de la redención y de la carne.

**1016** Por la muerte, el alma se separa del cuerpo, pero en la resurrección Dios devolverá la vida incorruptible a nuestro cuerpo transformado, reuniéndolo con nuestra alma. Así como Cristo ha resucitado y vive para siempre, todos nosotros resucitaremos en el último día.

**1017** “Creemos en la verdadera resurrección de esta carne que poseemos ahora”. No obstante se siembra en el sepulcro un cuerpo corruptible, resucita un cuerpo incorruptible, “un cuerpo espiritual” (1 Co 15,44).

**1018** Como consecuencia del pecado original, el hombre debe sufrir “la muerte corporal, de la que el hombre se habría liberado, si no hubiera pecado”

**1019** Jesús, el Hijo de Dios, sufrió libremente la muerte por nosotros en una sumisión total y libre a la voluntad de Dios, su Padre. Por su muerte venció a la muerte, abriendo así a todos los hombres la posibilidad de la salvación
