## Sacraments

**RECONCILIATION** - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

**BAPTISM** - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK** - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

**PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION** - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY** - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

**SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS** If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

I am happy to announce that we have a new priest living with us at St. John Neumann!

Fr. Philemon Okoh, CM is the new chaplain to the Coast Guard Base in Cape May. As Lieutenant and Catholic Chaplain, he serves the spiritual and religious needs of all the recruits and others on base, Catholic or otherwise!

Fr. Phil is a member of the Congregation of the Mission, or Vincentians, the religious order of men founded by St. Vincent de Paul. Originally from Nigeria, he is one of 16 brothers and sisters! A few of those siblings also live in the United States.



Ordained for the Vincentians, he has been a priest for 25 years. For the past 20 of those years, he has served here in the United States. Fourteen years ago, he felt a call to serve in the US Navy. Most recently he was chaplain to the US Navy Base in Norfolk, VA.

Though he will be residing at the rectory in North Cape May, most of his ministry will be at the Coast Guard Base. As a religious he will also spend some time with his Vincentian community (the closest house is the Basilica Shrine of the Miraculous Medal in Germantown, Philadelphia).

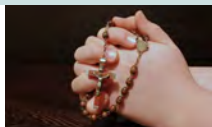

## RETREAT WITH FR. CESAR

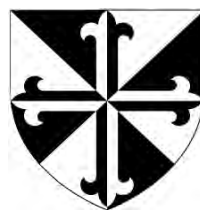

This happened in the year of the Russian Revolution, which led to the formation of the atheist Soviet regime and its attempts at world domination.

The Church earnestly recommends the pious custom of burying the bodies of the deceased. However, it does not forbid cremation -- unless it has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching. Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form and, as such, they should be treated with the same respect and dignity as a full body. The Church teaches that cremated remains must be reverently buried or entombed in a sacred place reserved for the burial of the dead. When choosing cremation, several respectful and meaningful options are available, including:

Ground Burial † Granite or Glass Niches † Private Family Cremation Estates

† Placement in an Existing Family Lot, Crypt or Niche

These choices ensure that the remains are honored and remembered in a manner consistent with faith and tradition. - Born John Cuidad, 8th March 1495 in Montemor O Novo, Portugal.
- Opened his hospital for poor, sick and dying in Granada, Spain 1537.
- Died in Granada 8th March 1550, aged 55 years.
- Declared a Saint by Pope Alexander VIII on 11th October 1690.
- Declared Patron of Sick and Dying by Pope Leo XIII, and declared Patron of Hospitals and all who work in them by Pope Pius XI.

## Los Siete Sacramentos de la Iglesia

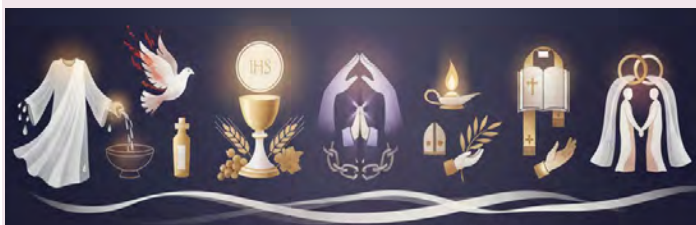
*Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica*

### II. MORIR EN CRISTO JESÚS. RESUMEN

**1210** Los sacramentos de la Nueva Ley fueron instituidos por Cristo y son siete, a saber, Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucaristía, Penitencia, Unción de los enfermos, Orden sacerdotal y Matrimonio. Los siete sacramentos corresponden a todas las etapas y todos los momentos importantes de la vida del cristianismo: dan nacimientos y crecimiento, curación y misión a la vida de fe de los cristianos. Hay aquí una cierta semejanza entre las etapas de la vida natural y las etapas de la vida espiritual.

**1211** Siguiendo esta analogía se explicarán en primer lugar los tres sacramentos de la iniciación cristiana (Capítulo primero), luego los sacramentos de la curación (Capítulo segundo), finalmente, los sacramentos que están al servicio de la comunión y misión de los fieles (Capítulo tercero). Ciertamente este orden no es el único posible, pero permite ver que los sacramentos forman un organismo en el cual cada sacramento particular tiene su lugar vital. En este organismo, la Eucaristía ocupa un lugar único, en cuanto “sacramento de los sacramentos”: “todos los otros sacramentos están ordenados a éste como a su fin” ijo de Dios, sufrió libremente la muerte por nosotros en una sumisión total y libre a la voluntad de Dios, su Padre. Por su muerte venció a la muerte, abriendo así a todos los hombres la posibilidad de la salvación
