

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30PM - 3:30PM at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9:00AM Daily Mass at St. John of God; Every Thursday following 9:00AM Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9:00AM Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST

AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

In a sense this article is a "week early." Next weekend we will be

celebrating All Saints Day and The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day). These two feasts are the times that we commemorate the dead from the Church, our families, and all the world. As All Saints Day falls on Saturday, the Solemnity will be celebrated only on Saturday Morning at the time of the First Saturday Mass, St. Raymond Church, 9:00am. It is without obligation this year.

On Saturday evening and Sunday, we will celebrate All Souls Day. This feast is when priests don black or violet vestments and we pray for all the Holy Souls in Purgatory. The custom in most places in the United States is that we write the names of our departed loved ones on envelopes which are collected on or near November 2. Then those envelopes are placed on or near the Altar of Sacrifice for the month of November. On November 2, 3, 11, 14, 19, and 27 the intention for Mass will be for those whose names are on the envelopes and all the Faithful Departed.

Additionally, there will be a book in the vestibule of each of our churches during Mass times where you can record the names of departed loved ones. Particularly, we inscribe the name and date of death of those who have passed away since last All Souls Day.

As November quickly approaches, we remember to pray for the dead: that they soon see the face of God and intercede for us!





Reminders regarding Mass in Spanish

Also, beginning **October 29th**, daily Mass in Spanish will now include Wednesdays. So, daily Mass in Spanish will occur each weeknight at 7pm at St. Raymond. We are blessed!

BEREAVEMENT MINISTRY NEWS

A Special Indulgence for the Holy Souls

November is the time in the Liturgical year when the Church calls us to pray for the Holy souls in Purgatory.

From November 1st to the 8th, a plenary indulgence can be granted to the souls of our loved ones or to a soul with no one to pray for them. To gain this plenary indulgence, you must be detached from all sin, visit a cemetery and pray for the dead, make a sacramental confession (within 20 days), receive Holy Communion, and pray for the Pope's intentions (Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be) (cfr. Apostolic Constitution on Indulgences nos. 7&8).

The indulgence can be gained on each day from November 1st to the 8th as long as you complete the requirements. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate visit to a cemetery, Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Pope's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence.

During these days in November the members of the Bereavement Ministry plan to visit our local cemeteries to pray for the Holy Souls, and we invite you to do the same.

During the month of November, we also plan to honor our deceased parishioners, family members and friends with prayer. Praying for the dead is a rich Catholic tradition. Please, join us to pray the Rosary for the dead every Monday and Thursday in November.

Mondays we will pray the rosary at 2:10pm in the Chapel, immediately after the Blessed Sacrament is reposed.

Thursdays we will join with the Lay Dominicans to pray the Rosary for the dead at 5:30pm in the Chapel.

Come and join us in honoring and praying for the Holy Souls through the intercession of Our Blessed Mother.

Paver Project





Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica Los Siete Sacramentos de la Iglesia

Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucarística, Penitencia, Unción de los enfermos, Orden Sacerdotal y Matrimonio

Capítulo Primero Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

Artículo 1 EL SACRAMENTO DEL BAUTISMO

EL NOMBRE DE ESTE SACRAMENTO

1214 Este sacramento recibe el nombre de *Bautismo* en razón del carácter del rito central mediante el que se celebra: bautizar (*baptizein* en griego) significa "sumergir", "introducir dentro del agua"; la "inmersión" en el agua simboliza el acto de sepultar al catecúmeno en la muerte de Cristo de donde sale por la resurrección con El como "nueva criatura" (*2 Co* 5, 17; *Ga* 6, 15).

1215 Este sacramento es llamado también "baño de regeneración y de renovación del Espíritu Santo" (Tt 3, 5), porque significa y realiza ese nacimiento del agua y del Espíritu sin el cual "nadie puede entrar en el Reino de Dios" (Jn 3, 5).

1216 "Este baño se llama *iluminación*, para dar a entender que son iluminados los que aprenden estas cosas". Habiendo recibido en el Bautismo al Verbo, "la luz verdadera que ilumina a todo hombre" (*Jn* 1, 9), el bautizado, "tras haber sido iluminado" (*Hb* 10,32), se convierte en "hijo de la luz" (*1 Ts* 5, 5), y en "luz" él mismo (*Ef* 5, 8):

El Bautismo es el más bello y magnífico de los dones de Dios... lo llamamos don, gracia, unción, iluminación, vestidura de incorruptibilidad, baño de regeneración, sello y todo lo más precioso que hay. *Don*, porque es conferido a los que no aportan nada; *gracia*, porque, es dado incluso a culpables; *bautismo*, porque el pecado es sepultado en el agua; *unción*, porque es sagrado y real (tales son los que son ungidos); *iluminación*, porque es luz resplandeciente; *vestidura*, porque cubre nuestra vergüenza; *baño*, porque lava; *sello*, porque nos guarda y es el signo de la soberanía de Dios.
