

Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-3:30pm at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9am daily Mass at St. John of God; every Thursday following 9am Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9am Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF

EUCARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll

your child in our Religious Education Program.

Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to or email one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Glory to Jesus Christ!

This week we will enter the final "stretch" of Advent, sort of the equivalent of Holy Week before Easter. From December 17 through Dec 24 the Church meditates on the "O Antiphons" at evening prayer of the Liturgy of the Hours. These are sung before the Magnificat (My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord) during the Church's prayer. They also appear as the Alleluia verse at daily Mass during these days. The Advent carol "O Come O Come Emmanuel" is based on these. For the coming week we meditate on:

O Wisdom of our God Most High,
guiding creation with power and love:
come to teach us the path of knowledge!

December 18

O Leader of the House of Israel,
giver of the Law to Moses on Sinai:
come to rescue us with your mighty power!

December 19

O Root of Jesse's stem,
sign of God's love for all his people:
come to save us without delay!

December 20

O Key of David,
opening the gates of God's eternal Kingdom:
come and free the prisoners of darkness!

May these be fruitful meditation to prepare
for Christmas!



Capítulo Primero

Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

Artículo 1 EL SACRAMENTO DEL BAUTISMO

III LA CELEBRACIÓN DEL SACRAMENTO DEL BAUTISMO

La iniciación cristiana

1233 Hoy, pues, en todos los ritos latinos y orientales, la iniciación cristiana de adultos comienza con su entrada en el catecumenado, para alcanzar su punto culminante en una sola celebración de los tres sacramentos del Bautismo, de la Confirmación y de la Eucaristía. En los ritos orientales la iniciación cristiana de los niños comienza con el Bautismo, seguido inmediatamente por la Confirmación y la Eucaristía, mientras que en el rito romano se continúa durante unos años de catequesis para acabar más tarde con la Confirmación y la Eucaristía, cima de su iniciación cristiana.

La mistagogia de la celebración

1234 El sentido y la gracia del sacramento del Bautismo aparece claramente en los ritos de su celebración. Cuando se participa atentamente en los gestos y las palabras de esta celebración, los fieles se inician en las riquezas que este sacramento significa y realiza en cada nuevo bautizado.

1235 *La señal de la Cruz*, al comienzo de la celebración, señala la impronta de Cristo sobre el que le va a pertenecer y significa la gracia de la redención que Cristo nos ha adquirido por su cruz.

1236 *El anuncio de la Palabra de Dios* ilumina con la verdad revelada a los candidatos y a la asamblea y suscita la respuesta de la fe, inseparable del Bautismo. En efecto, el Bautismo es de un modo particular “el sacramento de la fe” por ser la entrada sacramental en la vida de fe.

1237 Puesto que el Bautismo significa la liberación del pecado y de su instigador, el diablo, se pronuncian uno o varios *exorcismos* sobre el candidato. Este es ungido con el óleo de los catecumenos o bien el celebrante le impone la mano y el candidato renuncia explícitamente a Satanás. Así preparado, puede *confesar la fe de la Iglesia*, a la cual será “confiado” por el Bautismo.






