**RECONCILIATION** - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-

### PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF

Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that  
the child is ready, usually in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades  
and after a minimum of 2 years of religious

Some updates from around the  
parish:

Over the past 15 years or so, the Chapel at St. Raymond Church had grown neglected. There was always the smell of mold/mildew. This is what happens when an older building does not receive sufficient use or maintenance. Our Regional Hispanic Ministry has been using the chapel for daily Mass more and more. After the donation of a generous benefactor and some fundraising, the chapel will now be renovated with new flooring and upholstery. We look forward to seeing a renewal of this sacred space!

Several of the heating/cooling units in the parish offices have stopped working correctly. Barbara, our business manager, has been quite cold! We attempted to have them repaired but the technology is antiquated. With the approval of the parish finance council and the diocese, we will be installing new units in all the offices at St. John of God.

Last year the parish finance council approved new windows for the St. Raymond School building. This will help us become more energy efficient after getting a new roof and a new boiler. The windows will be replaced in the coming months.

We also hope to continue to renew and refresh the bathrooms in the halls and churches.

Many of our buildings are from the 1960's and earlier. We strive to be good stewards of our churches and buildings. Thank you for your continued generosity to our parish!


## **MARCH FOR LIFE**



Detail from *Saint John the Baptist, Saint Fabian and Saint Sebastian* | Miguel Ximénez

Saint Fabian was a Roman layman who came into the city from his farm one day as clergy and people were preparing to elect a new pope. Eusebius, a Church historian, says a dove flew in and settled on the head of Fabian. This sign united the votes of clergy and laity, and he was chosen unanimously.

He led the Church for 14 years and died a martyr's death during the persecution of Decius in 250 A.D. Saint Cyprian wrote to his successor that Fabian was an "incomparable" man whose glory in death matched the holiness and purity of his life.

In the catacombs of Saint Callistus, the stone that covered Fabian's grave may still be seen, broken into four pieces, bearing the Greek words, "Fabian, bishop, martyr." Saint Fabian shares the celebration of his liturgical feast with Saint Sebastian on January 20.

Saint Fabian doesn't have one single, widely recognized patronage like some other saints, but he's invoked for church administration, evangelization, and protecting against heresy, due to his actions organizing the Church in Rome and sending missionaries to Gaul, and he's honored alongside St. Sebastian on January 20th for general Catholic devotion.

#### **Artículo 1 EL SACRAMENTO DEL BAUTISMO**

#### **IV QUIEN PUEDE RECIBIR EL BAUTISMO**

#### **Fe y Bautismo**

**1253** El Bautismo es el sacramento de la fe (cf Mc 16,16). Pero la fe tiene necesidad de la comunidad de creyentes. Sólo en la fe de la Iglesia puede creer cada uno de los fieles. La fe que se requiere para el Bautismo no es una fe perfecta y madura, sino un comienzo que está llamado a desarrollarse. Al catecúmeno o a su padrino se le pregunta: "¿Qué pides a la Iglesia de Dios?" y él responde: "¡La fe!".

**1254** En todos los bautizados, niños o adultos, la fe debe crecer después del Bautismo. Por eso, la Iglesia celebra cada año en la vigilia pascual la renovación de las promesas del Bautismo. La preparación al Bautismo sólo conduce al umbral de la vida nueva. El Bautismo es la fuente de la vida nueva en Cristo, de la cual brota toda la vida cristiana.

**1255** Para que la gracia bautismal pueda desarrollarse es importante la ayuda de los padres. Ese es también el papel del padrino o de la madrina, que deben ser creyentes sólidos, capaces y prestos a ayudar al nuevo bautizado, niño o adulto, en su camino de la vida cristiana (cf CIC can. 872-874). Su tarea es una verdadera función eclesial (officium; cf SC 67). Toda la comunidad eclesial participa de la responsabilidad de desarrollar y guardar la gracia recibida en el Bautismo.
