

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-
3:30pm at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to
9am daily Mass at St. John of God; every Thursday
following 9am Mass at St. John of God; First
Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9am Mass; also
Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish).
Confession also available by appointment with a
priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to
call or make an appointment at the office for
baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is
celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday
Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate
from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously
ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due
to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest
for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call
the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of
Holy Communion are available to bring Communion
to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in
the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to
continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF

EUCCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll
your child in our Religious Education Program.
Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that
the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades
and after a minimum of 2 years of religious
formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more
information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or
groom may contact the parish office requesting to be
married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12
months. Please speak to or email one of the priests to
confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - If a man from our
parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or
diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr.
Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of



Capítulo Primero

Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

Artículo 1 EL SACRAMENTO DEL BAUTISMO

V QUIEN PUEDE BAUTIZAR

1256 Son ministros ordinarios del Bautismo el obispo y el presbítero y, en la Iglesia latina, también el diácono (cf CIC, can. 861,1; CCEO, can. 677,1). En caso de necesidad, cualquier persona, incluso no bautizada, puede bautizar (cf CIC can. 861, § 2) si tiene la intención requerida y utiliza la fórmula bautismal trinitaria. La intención requerida consiste en querer hacer lo que hace la Iglesia al bautizar. La Iglesia ve la razón de esta posibilidad en la voluntad salvífica universal de Dios (cf 1 Tm 2,4) y en la necesidad del Bautismo para la salvación (cf Mc 16,16).

VI LA NECESIDAD DEL BAUTISMO

1257 El Señor mismo afirma que el Bautismo es necesario para la salvación (cf Jn 3,5). Por ello mandó a sus discípulos a anunciar el Evangelio y bautizar a todas las naciones (cf Mt 28, 19-20; cf DS 1618; LG 14; AG 5). El Bautismo es necesario para la salvación en aquellos a los que el Evangelio ha sido anunciado y han tenido la posibilidad de pedir este sacramento (cf Mc 16,16). La Iglesia no conoce otro medio que el Bautismo para asegurar la entrada en la bienaventuranza eterna; por eso está obligada a no descuidar la misión que ha recibido del Señor de hacer "renacer del agua y del Espíritu" a todos los que pueden ser bautizados. *Dios ha vinculado la salvación al sacramento del Bautismo, sin embargo, Él no queda sometido a sus sacramentos.*

Ofrecer una intención para la Santa Misa es una hermosa y antigua tradición. Consiste en pedir que la Misa se celebre de manera especial por una persona o una intención concreta, como por ejemplo:

-  Un familiar fallecido
-  Una persona enferma
-  Una necesidad especial
-  Acción de gracias por un favor recibido
-  La paz, la familia o una situación difícil

De manera especial, la Iglesia nos invita a ofrecer intenciones por nuestros difuntos. Al hacerlo, oramos para que el Señor, en su infinita misericordia, les conceda el descanso eterno y la plenitud de su presencia. Esto es una obra de misericordia espiritual y una expresión de amor que trasciende la muerte.
