## Sacraments

**RECONCILIATION** - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-3:30pm at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9am daily Mass at St. John of God; every Thursday following 9am Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9am Mass; also Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish). Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

**BAPTISM** - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK** - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

### PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF

**EUCCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION** - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more information.

**SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY** - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to or email one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

**SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS** - If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr. Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

Glory To Jesus Christ!

At every Mass there is a specific intention. Sometimes this is for all the people of the parish, living and deceased. Other times it is for a certain individual and, twice a week, there are multiple intentions for the particular Mass. When the priest prays the Mass, he is offering it primarily for that intention. This does not exclude his own intentions or the intentions that the people attending are praying for.

Similarly, we can make a sacrifice or pray for a particular intention. Most of us have prayed for a particular person or cause at some time; maybe we have offered a novena (9 days of prayer) for a particular intention. With just a few days before Lent begins, I ask you to consider what your Lenten intention or intentions are this year. Is there someone or some cause that you would like to pray for? How about something in our country or in our world? There is so much that we can pray for.

This Lent I encourage you to set a specific intention or set of intentions. That way when we fast, pray, and give alms, we can offer them up for those for whom we are praying. Like at Mass, it doesn't preclude us from praying for other people or intentions, but it does focus us more clearly on the Lord.



**The Book of Ruth: A Love Story That Isn't as Weird as You Think**



*Practicing Catholic Podcast*—The Book of Ruth can feel strange to modern readers—but beneath its unfamiliar customs is one of Scripture's most beautiful stories of fidelity, love, and God's providence. In this episode of the Practicing Catholic Podcast, we begin a new Bible study by taking a fresh look at Ruth and why this short Old Testament book matters so much for Christians today.

Together, we explore the historical and cultural context of Ruth, unpacking themes of loyalty, family, and redemption that often get overlooked. This conversation helps listeners see how Ruth fits into the larger story of salvation history—and why the Church continues to return to it as a source of wisdom and hope.

This is part one of our Practicing Catholic Bible study on the Book of Ruth, setting the foundation for a deeper dive in the next episode.



## Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica Los Siete Sacramentos de la Iglesia

*Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucarística, Penitencia,  
Unción de los enfermos, Orden Sacerdotal y Matrimonio*

### Capítulo Primero

### Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

### Artículo 1 EL SACRAMENTO DEL BAUTISMO

#### VII LA GRACIA DEL BAUTISMO

**1262** Los distintos efectos del Bautismo son significados por los elementos sensibles del rito sacramental. La inmersión en el agua evoca los simbolismos de la muerte y de la purificación, pero también los de la regeneración y de la renovación. Los dos efectos principales, por tanto, son la purificación de los pecados y el nuevo nacimiento en el Espíritu Santo (cf Hch 2,38; Jn 3,5).

#### Para la remisión de los pecados...

**1263** Por el Bautismo, todos los pecados son perdonados, el pecado original y todos los pecados personales así como todas las penas del pecado (cf DS 1316). En efecto, en los que han sido regenerados no permanece nada que les impida entrar en el Reino de Dios, ni el pecado de Adán, ni el pecado personal, ni las consecuencias del pecado, la más grave de las cuales es la separación de Dios.

**1264** No obstante, en el bautizado permanecen ciertas consecuencias temporales del pecado, como los sufrimientos, la enfermedad, la muerte o las fragilidades inherentes a la vida como las debilidades de carácter, etc., así como una inclinación al pecado que la Tradición llama concupiscencia, o metafóricamente fomes peccati: «La concupiscencia, dejada para el combate, no puede dañar a los que no la consienten y la resisten con coraje por la gracia de Jesucristo. Antes bien "el que legítimamente luchare, será coronado" (2 Tm 2,5)» (Concilio de Trento: DS 1515).
