RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-
3:30pm at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to
9am daily Mass at St. John of God; every Thursday

Monday and Thursday evenings after Mass (Spanish).
Confession also available by appointment with a
priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to
call or make an appointment at the office for
baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is
celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday
Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate
from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously
ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due
to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest
for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call
the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of
Holy Communion are available to bring Communion
to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in
the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to
continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF

EUCCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll
your child in our Religious Education Program.
Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that
the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades
and after a minimum of 2 years of religious
formation. Please call Sr. Kathleen for more
information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or
groom may contact the parish office requesting to be
married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12
months. Please speak to or email one of the priests to
confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - If a man from our
parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or
diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. King or Fr.
Cesar to explore this calling or call the Office of

Glory to Jesus Christ!

This is the first weekend that we are celebrating Ordinary Time since before Lent. In some ways we are back to "normal." But "ordinary" doesn't mean common. It comes from the Latin word meaning "Ordinal" or the counting of time: first week, second week, third week, etc.

During the past few weeks, we celebrated the mysteries of our faith: the Trinity, the Body and Blood of our Lord, His Sacred Heart. Now we return to our daily discipleship. What are the devotions and practices that we engage in during our "ordinary" time?

Whatever it is you do - Scripture reading, rosary, Liturgy of the Hours, morning devotions - I would ask you to please add at least five minutes of prayer daily for an increase in vocations to priesthood and religious life in our diocese. In 2026 three priests have retired and two have stepped back from ministry. Only one new priest was ordained. In the recent transfers of priests, we have one parish that is not receiving a new pastor (it will be merging) and others that are going from having full-time priests to only part-time priests. Our own parish is going from two to one priest.

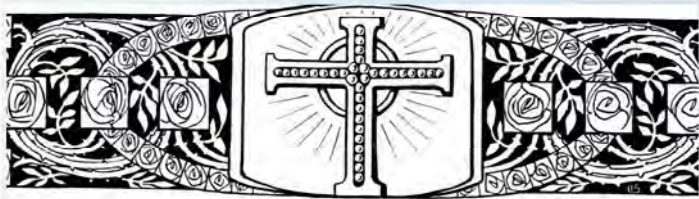
Some projections say that by the year 2030 we may have more parishes than active priests serving the diocese. So please encourage young men to join the priesthood, especially for our diocese. Encourage young men and women to consider religious life. Ask your children, your grandchildren.

Someone asked me recently why we are losing two priests and only gaining one. And why the convent is closing. The simplest answer is that there aren't enough priests and religious to keep them open.

Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica

Los Siete Sacramentos de la Iglesia

Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucarística, Penitencia, Unción de los enfermos, Orden Sacerdotal y Matrimonio

Capítulo Primero

Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

Artículo 2 EL SACRAMENTO DE LA CONFIRMACIÓN

1298 Cuando la Confirmación se celebra separadamente del Bautismo, como es el caso en el rito romano, la liturgia del sacramento comienza con la renovación de las promesas del Bautismo y la profesión de fe de los confirmandos. Así aparece claramente que la Confirmación constituye una prolongación del Bautismo (cf SC 71). Cuando es bautizado un adulto, recibe inmediatamente la Confirmación y participa en la Eucaristía (cf CIC can.866).

1299 En el rito romano, el obispo extiende las manos sobre todos los confirmandos, gesto que, desde el tiempo de los Apóstoles, es el signo del don del Espíritu. Y el obispo invoca así la efusión del Espíritu:

«Dios Todopoderoso, Padre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, que regeneraste, por el agua y el Espíritu Santo, a estos siervos tuyos y los libraste del pecado: escucha nuestra oración y envía sobre ellos el Espíritu Santo Paráclito; llénalos de espíritu de sabiduría y de inteligencia, de espíritu de consejo y de fortaleza, de espíritu de ciencia y de piedad; y cólmalos del espíritu de tu santo temor. Por Jesucristo nuestro Señor» (Ritual de la Confirmación, 25).

1300 Sigue el rito esencial del sacramento. En el rito latino, "el sacramento de la Confirmación es conferido por la unción del santo crisma en la frente, hecha imponiendo la mano, y con estas palabras: "Recibe por esta señal el don del Espíritu Santo" (Pablo VI, Const. ap. Divinae consortium naturae).
