Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-3:30pm at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9am daily Mass at St. John of God; every Thursday following 9am Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9am Mass; Fridays at 7pm prior to 8pm Mass in Spanish. Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the 4pm Vigil Mass at St. John of God or after the 7pm Sunday Mass at St. Raymond. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF

EUCCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call our DSF for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to or email Fr. Hostios to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. Hostios to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

HIS WORD TODAY

**Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
August 9, 2026**

“Then the Lord said to him, ‘Go outside and stand on the mountain before the Lord; the Lord will be passing by...but the Lord was not in the wind...but the Lord was not in the earthquake...but the Lord was not in fire...after that there was a tiny whispering sound. When he heard this Elijah hid his face in his cloak and went and stood at the entrance of the cave.’... “Lord if it is you, command me to come to you on the water.” He said, ‘Come.’”

How often do we see the Lord's hand being present in our lives, especially when we are in need. It seems to be the only way to describe the successful outcome to a threat or crisis. That is when extraordinary events occur. But what about the normal, daily occurrences which occur. The same Lord is present to support, guide and direct us, but we need to open both our eyes and hearts. Maybe that is the tiny whispering sound we often overlook. Assume the role of Peter saying, ‘Lord if it is you. And he tells us to come. Our loving God is present in the ordinary as well as the extraordinary.’

Because we are down to one priest, our Parish Budget has much changed. We will have our new numbers published soon. Thank you for your patience!

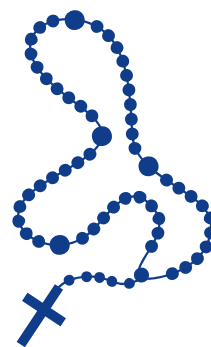

Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica Los Siete Sacramentos de la Iglesia

**Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucarística, Penitencia,
Unción de los enfermos, Orden Sacerdotal y Matrimonio**

Capítulo Primero

Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

Artículo 2 EL SACRAMENTO DE LA CONFIRMACIÓN

1313 En el rito latino, el ministro ordinario de la Confirmación es el obispo (CIC can. 882). Aunque el obispo puede, en caso de necesidad, conceder a presbíteros la facultad de administrar el sacramento de la Confirmación (CIC can. 884,2), conviene que lo confiera él mismo, sin olvidar que por esta razón la celebración de la Confirmación fue temporalmente separada del Bautismo. Los obispos son los sucesores de los Apóstoles y han recibido la plenitud del sacramento del orden. Por esta razón, la administración de este sacramento por ellos mismos pone de relieve que la Confirmación tiene como efecto unir a los que la reciben más estrechamente a la Iglesia, a sus orígenes apostólicos y a su misión de dar testimonio de Cristo.

1314 Si un cristiano está en peligro de muerte, cualquier presbítero puede darle la Confirmación (cf CIC can. 883,3). En efecto, la Iglesia quiere que ninguno de sus hijos, incluso en la más tierna edad, salga de este mundo sin haber sido perfeccionado por el Espíritu Santo con el don de la plenitud de Cristo.

Resumen

1315 "Al enterarse los Apóstoles que estaban en Jerusalén de que Samaria había aceptado la Palabra de Dios, les enviaron a Pedro y a Juan. Estos bajaron y oraron por ellos para que recibieran el Espíritu Santo; pues todavía no había descendido sobre ninguno de ellos; únicamente habían sido bautizados en el nombre del Señor Jesús. Entonces les imponían las manos y recibían el Espíritu Santo" (Hch 8,14-17).

1316 La Confirmación perfecciona la gracia bautismal; es el sacramento que da el Espíritu Santo para enraizarnos más profundamente en la filiación divina, incorporarnos más firmemente a Cristo, hacer más sólido nuestro vínculo con la Iglesia, asociarnos todavía más a su misión y ayudarnos a dar testimonio de la fe cristiana por la palabra acompañada de las obras.

1317 La Confirmación, como el Bautismo, imprime en el alma del cristiano un signo espiritual o carácter indeleble; por eso este sacramento sólo se puede recibir una vez en la vida.

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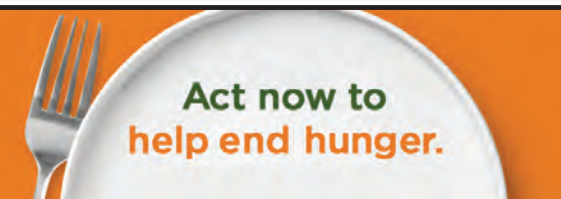
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
