Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-3:30pm at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9am daily Mass at St. John of God; every Thursday following 9am Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9am Mass; Fridays at 7pm prior to 8pm Mass in Spanish. Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the 4pm Vigil Mass at St. John of God or after the 7pm Sunday Mass at St. Raymond. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call our DSF for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to or email Fr. Hostios to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. Hostios to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

HIS WORD TODAY

Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time
September 6th, 2026

“You, son of man, I have appointed watchman for the house of Israel... But if you warn the wicked man, trying to turn him from his way, and he refuses to turn from his way, he shall die for his guilt... If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won him over... if two of you agree about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.”

No one likes to have someone tell him that they are doing something wrong, and many hesitate to offer correction. But the saying goes that the only way for evil to triumph is for good persons to do nothing. As we try to grow as Christians, we are obliged to speak up and speak out to change, whether individually or collectively.

Matthew offers the key to unity and change as he says, ‘if he listens to you.’ Listening allows us to think, deliberate, and then act. This provides the opportunity to join with the two or three, and discover that the Lord is present to resolve whatever difficulty. Yes, ‘the Spirit of the Lord present in me, greets the Spirit of the Lord present in you.’

Los Siete Sacramentos de la Iglesia

Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucarística, Penitencia, Unción de los enfermos, Orden Sacerdotal y Matrimonio

Capítulo Primero

Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

Artículo 3 EL SACRAMENTO DE LA EUCARISTÍA

1322 La Sagrada Eucaristía culmina la iniciación cristiana. Los que han sido elevados a la dignidad del sacerdocio real por el Bautismo y configurados más profundamente con Cristo por la Confirmación, participan por medio de la Eucaristía con toda la comunidad en el sacrificio mismo del Señor.

1323 "Nuestro Salvador, en la última Cena, la noche en que fue entregado, instituyó el Sacrificio Eucarístico de su cuerpo y su sangre para perpetuar por los siglos, hasta su vuelta, el sacrificio de la cruz y confiar así a su Esposa amada, la Iglesia, el memorial de su muerte y resurrección, sacramento de piedad, signo de unidad, vínculo de amor, banquete pascual en el que se recibe a Cristo, el alma se llena de gracia y se nos da una prenda de la gloria futura" (SC 47).

1324 La Eucaristía es "fuente y culmen de toda la vida cristiana" (LG 11). "Los demás sacramentos, como también todos los ministerios eclesiales y las obras de apostolado, están unidos a la Eucaristía y a ella se ordenan. La sagrada Eucaristía, en efecto, contiene todo el bien espiritual de la Iglesia, es decir, Cristo mismo, nuestra Pascua" (PO 5).

1325 "La comunión de vida divina y la unidad del Pueblo de Dios, sobre los que la propia Iglesia subsiste, se significan adecuadamente y se realizan de manera admirable en la Eucaristía. En ella se encuentra a la vez la cumbre de la acción por la que, en Cristo, Dios santifica al mundo, y del culto que en el Espíritu Santo los hombres dan a Cristo y por él al Padre" (Instr. Eucharisticum mysterium, 6).

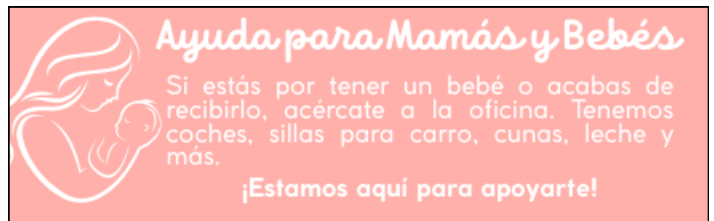
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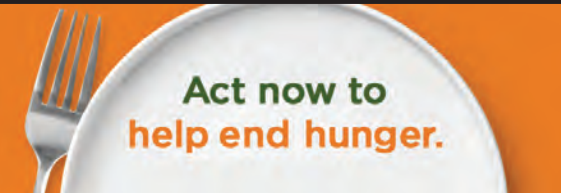
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
