Sacraments

RECONCILIATION - Every Saturday, 2:30pm-3:30pm at St. John of God; every Wednesday prior to 9am daily Mass at St. John of God; every Thursday following 9am Mass at St. John of God; First Saturdays at St. Raymond following 9am Mass; Fridays at 7pm prior to 8pm Mass in Spanish. Confession also available by appointment with a priest at the Parish Office.

BAPTISM - Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated after the 4pm Vigil Mass at St. John of God or after the 7pm Sunday Mass at St. Raymond. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK - If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age, they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the home-bound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF

EUCCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION - Please enroll your child in our Religious Education Program. Sacraments are given when the parish assesses that the child is ready, usually in the 2nd and 8th grades and after a minimum of 2 years of religious formation. Please call our DSF for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to or email Fr. Hostios to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - If a man from our parish feels he may be called to the priesthood or diaconate, he is invited to speak with Fr. Hostios to explore this calling or call the Office of Vocations: 856-583-2864, or visit: camdenpriest.org.

**Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time
September 27, 2026**

"Have in you the same attitude that is also in Christ Jesus, who though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness, and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."

How beautiful the teaching of Saint Paul calling us to be like Jesus. Reread these powerful words. Remember, this is God wishing to join us, the human race, while still remaining God, because of His love, wanting to save and rescue us. He came because of our need.

We often hear the expression, 'you have an attitude', usually reflecting a negative judgment. Not so today, as Paul is encouraging us to assume our oneness with Jesus, giving of ourselves, as He who emptied, poured out everything for us and our salvation. That attitude can be one of service and care so that others know how great Jesus' love is for them today.

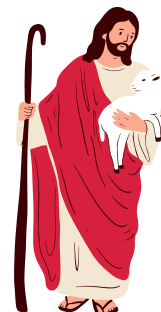

We have good news for Grandparents/Godparents: There are now two options for you to join our monthly Catholic Grandparents gatherings.

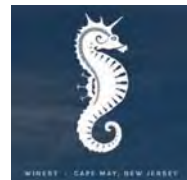

Capítulo Primero

Los Sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana

Artículo 3 EL SACRAMENTO DE LA EUCARISTÍA

1330 Memorial de la pasión y de la resurrección del Señor.

Santo Sacrificio, porque actualiza el único sacrificio de Cristo Salvador e incluye la ofrenda de la Iglesia; o también *Santo Sacrificio de la Misa*, "*sacrificio de alabanza*" (Hch 13,15; cf Sal 116, 13.17), *sacrificio espiritual* (cf 1 P 2,5), *sacrificio puro* (cf Ml 1,11) y *santo*, puesto que completa y supera todos los sacrificios de la Antigua Alianza.

Santa y divina liturgia, porque toda la liturgia de la Iglesia encuentra su centro y su expresión más densa en la celebración de este sacramento; en el mismo sentido se la llama también *celebración de los santos misterios*. Se habla también del *Santísimo Sacramento* porque es el Sacramento de los Sacramentos. Con este nombre se designan las especies eucarísticas guardadas en el sagrario.

1331 Comunión, porque por este sacramento nos unimos a Cristo que nos hace partícipes de su Cuerpo y de su Sangre para formar un solo cuerpo (cf 1 Co 10,16-17); se la llama también las cosas santas [ta hagia; sancta] (Constitutiones apostolicae 8, 13, 12; Didaché 9,5; 10,6) —es el sentido primero de la "comunión de los santos" de que habla el Símbolo de los Apóstoles—, pan de los ángeles, pan del cielo, medicina de inmortalidad (San Ignacio de Antioquía, Epistula ad Ephsios, 20,2), viático...

1332 Santa Misa porque la liturgia en la que se realiza el misterio de salvación se termina con el envío de los fieles ("missio") a fin de que cumplan la voluntad de Dios en su vida cotidiana.

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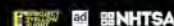
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
