#### Christ is Risen! Indeed, He is Risen!!

This Thursday, April 27, Bishop Sullivan will confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on fifteen (15) our religious education students and on another group from our neighboring parish, Our Lady Star of the Sea. It is always a grace to have Bishop Sullivan with us but more so when he is administering this Sacrament. Confirmation is the Sacrament by which we are "sealed with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit" and thus complete our Christian Initiation.

"For "by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed."(CCC 1285) indeed: "It is evident from its celebration that the effect of the Sacrament of Confirmation is the special outpouring of the Holy Spirit as once granted to the apostles on the day of Pentecost. From this fact, Confirmation brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace:

- it roots us more deeply in the divine filiation which makes us cry, "Abba! Father!";<sup>117</sup>
- it unites us more firmly to Christ;
- it increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us;
- it renders our bond with the Church more perfect;<sup>118</sup>
- it gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross:" CCC 1302-03.




