SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents or legal guardians are welcome to call or make an appointment at the office for baptismal preparation. Infant baptism is offered to children aged 7 and younger. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated either after or during one of the Sunday Masses. Godparents will need an eligibility certificate from their proper pastor.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

If someone is seriously ill, hospitalized, preparing for surgery, or failing due to advanced age they are welcome to call for a priest for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the office for arrangements. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are available to bring Communion to the homebound. The sick will be remembered in the bulletin for four (4) weeks; longer if requested to continue.

PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION

After two years of religious education, baptized children receive their First Holy Communion, usually the first weekend in May.

Confirmation is offered for those who have been baptized and received their First Holy Communion after several more years of instruction. Confirmation is usually administered when the young person is in the 8th grade. Please call Sr. Kathleen at the Religious Education office for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

The future bride or groom may contact the parish office requesting to be married. Marriage preparation usually takes 9-12 months. Please speak to one of the priests to confirm a date and arrange preparations.

From Father King

Christ is Risen!

For the next few weeks I will be using my "pastor's corner" to answer some of the questions that people have dropped in the box for "Questions about the Eucharist" in the back of our Churches. You may also hear some of these from the altar during the homily.

Today's Question: When we say '*Body of Christ*,' I believe the Eucharist contains God the Father, and the Holy Spirit. Is that correct?

This question touches on several areas of theology: Eucharistic theology, Christology, as well as theology of the Holy Trinity. First we need to look at the Trinity and the Incarnation. For eternity there has been one God in three divine persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. They are one in nature, in intellect, and in will. There was no time when the Son or the Holy Spirit did not exist: They are co-eternal with the Father. However, at the Incarnation (conception of Jesus) the Word was made Flesh. This mystery we refer to as the Annunciation and Incarnation. This is when the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, the Word, took on a human nature and became the man Jesus. He is One Divine Person with a human nature. The Father and the Holy Spirit did not take on human nature, only Jesus did.

However, throughout John's Gospel Jesus speaks of the Father and He being "one" (see John 14:11, 17:21). That is to say that The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit can never be separated from one another. Where there is One, the Others are present. This is what is called "perichoresis" or mutual-indwelling.

When we receive Holy Communion we receive "the Body of Christ." We do not receive the "body" of the Father or Spirit, as they did not become incarnate. However, we do dwell in Trinitarian grace and presence when we receive the Body of Christ because the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are One. John 14:8-10 says whoever has seen me (Christ) has seen the Father. May we approach with reverence the great Sacrament that we receive, and have Communion with the Trinity.

Indeed, Christ is Risen!

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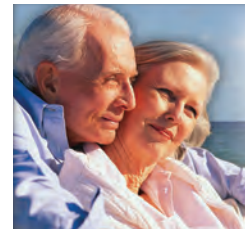
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
